Official Contest Rules

1. Contestants will provide their own accompaniment. Exact cue times will be given at time of check in.
2. Contestants may not give any signal to the DJ to alter music during performance. In such event, points will be deducted.
3. Contestants may not be in more than one category. Contestants must participate in the designated age category unless belonging to a crew in which the age majority of the crew falls under another category.
4. There is no cap on the number of crew numbers allowed to compete however; there may be no more than ten contestants on the stage at one time.
5. Points will be awarded on basis of: Costume Originality, Creativity, Level of Difficulty, Uniformity and Time Compliance.
6. There shall be a contestants meeting held prior to the beginning of the dance competition for the purposes of reviewing contest format and rules, drawing of running order and announcement of music selections. Music selections shall be played at the contestants' meeting.
7. Props are allowed however it is the sole discretion of ATR to determine if the props pose a liability or possible danger. Potential props must be included in the registration packet. They are defined as small handheld or worn objects that can be appropriately revealed, utilized, and retained (e.g., capes, tear-away skirts, hand-held flowers, spurs, parasols, canes, ropes, chairs, suitcases, etc.). No fire, smoke or water will be allowed in any dance routine. In other words, start with an empty, dry floor and exit with an empty, dry floor.
8. Contestants must be ready to perform when scheduled and/or called or shall be scored no show with zero (0) placement for that category.
9. Dance routines shall be no less than one minute and thirty seconds and no longer than three minutes and thirty seconds. Points will be deducted if these guidelines are not adhered.
10. All performing crew members must already be on the team's dance roster prior to the event. Last minute additions will not be allowed unless it is an even swap for a crew member's spot who is deemed unable to perform or unavailable to attend.
11. All Things Relative (ATR Productions) will not be held liable for any injuries or lost/stolen items during the duration of ATR's Dance Explosion.
12. Dance registration packets must be received or post marked by October 16, 2010.
13. Videotaping in any capacity is prohibited in this dance competition-Anyone with a video camera will not be allowed to enter the facility. That includes cellular phones-anyone seen videotaping with a cellular phone will be asked to leave the facility.
